Financial Assistance from ASPET

As part of ASPET's initiatives to be inclusive, we want to be sure no speaker is prevented from participation at our meeting due to a lack of theirs or their company/institution's financial resources.

To help make the meeting affordable for members, Council selected a hotel with a rate 30% lower than our EB 2022 hotel (\$189) and adjusted the schedule so the majority will only need a 3-night stay. They selected a city that is within driving distance to many with an average flight cost of \$316 (per USDOT). In addition, many meals will be provided by the conference.
