The final selection of symposia for the ASPET Annual Meeting at EB 2021 will take place in June 2020. You will be notified by July 1, 2020 if your symposium has been selected.

- Provisional agreement to speak (if selected) obtained from proposed speakers.
- Speaking order of speakers within symposium
- Each speakers' length of talk and length of their Q&A
- 100-word description of symposium suitable for publication
- 140 character social media description of symposium suitable for publication
- Upload of chair photos for publication
