#### April 15, 2013 Legislative Update: President Obama Releases Proposed NIH FY 2014 Budget

President Obama released his proposed FY 2014 budget on April 10. The President's budget proposes funding increases for most federal science agencies including the NIH at \$31.3 billion, a 1.5% or \$471 million increase for FY 2014. The President's budget proposal does not take into account the sequestered baseline amount in FY 2013, using instead FY 2012 as the baseline...


