LEGISLATIVE UPDATE: November 1, 2012 -Budget Cuts Threaten NIH Funding/Act Now

Days before the Presidential election, community efforts continue to raise awareness among lawmakers about the impact of sequestration -- mandatory across the board budget cuts that would reduce government spending by \$1.2 trillion over 10 years. These cuts are mandated by the 2011 Budget Control Act. If a lame-duck Congress cannot find some other alternative to reduce the deficit by \$1.2 trillion (through a more balanced combination of revenue and spending cuts), then the sequestration will become effective January 3...
